

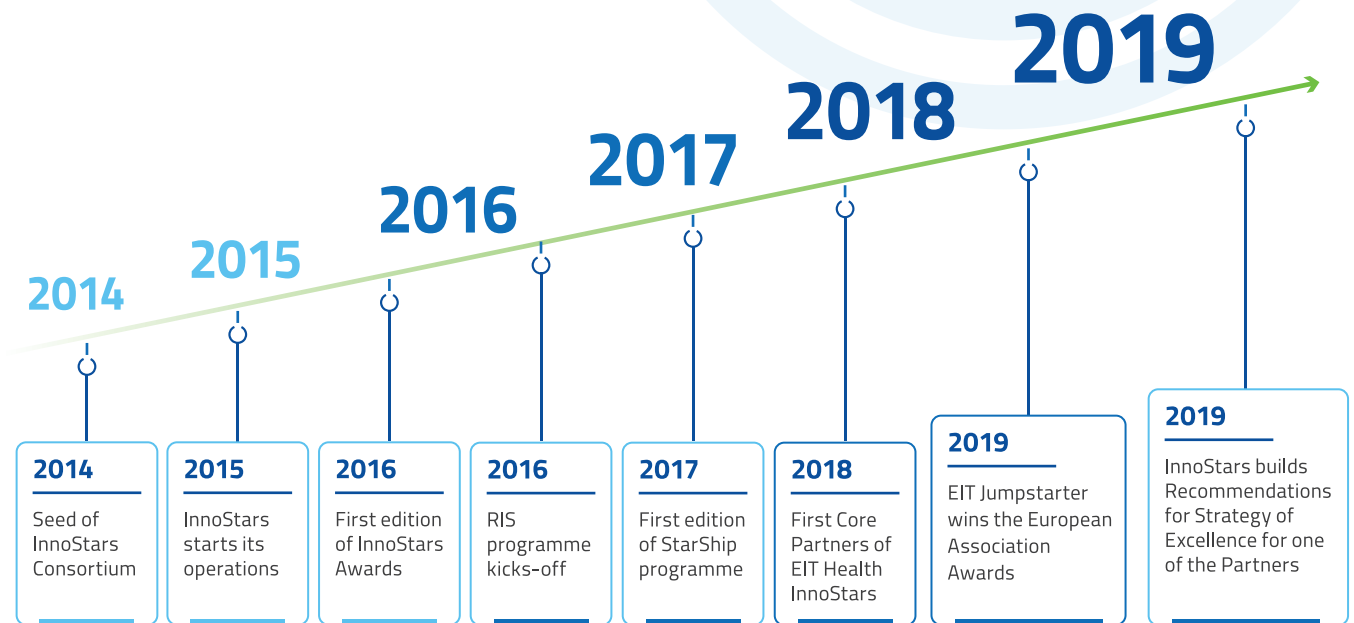

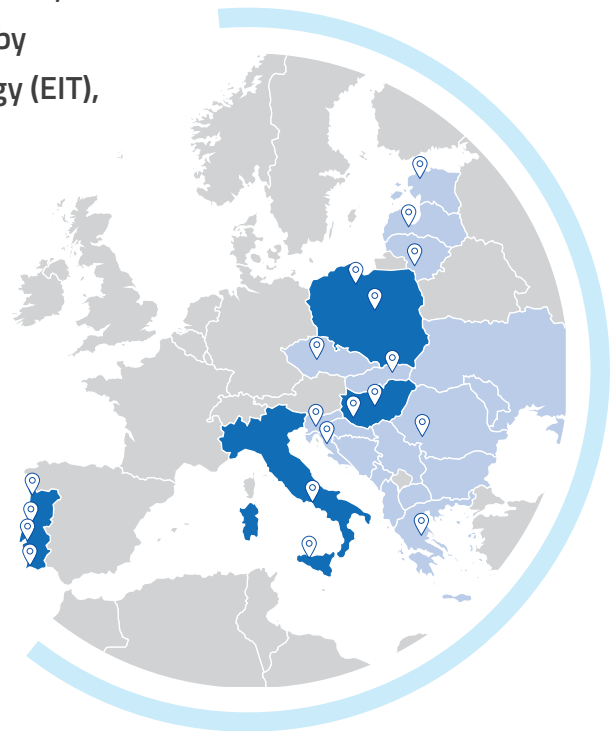

InnoStars covers half of Europe

InnoStars is focused on promoting entrepreneurship, innovation, and education in the domain of healthcare, healthy living and active ageing in the progressive regions within European countries where the overall pace of innovation is still moderate, according to the European Innovation Scoreboard (EIS).

Headquartered in Budapest, EIT Health InnoStars spans several geographic regions in Hungary, Italy, Poland and Portugal. This area includes the highest concentration of funding for European Structural and Investment Funds (ESIF) for innovation, with €20 billion available up to 2023.

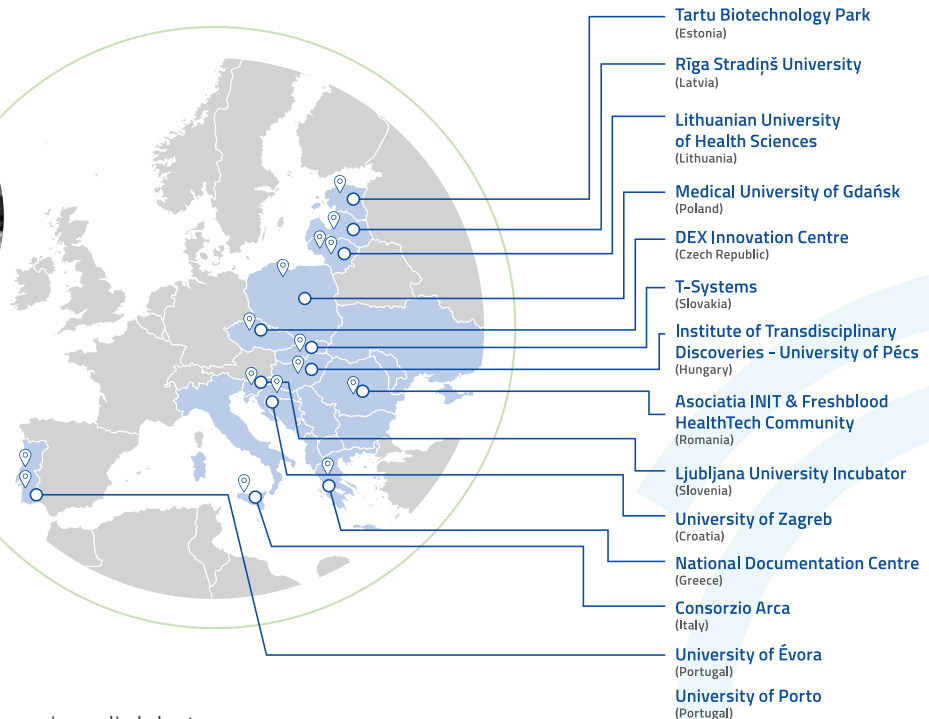
