- To provide or organise effective support, coaching, and training as required, and in collaboration with the Human Resources team where necessary, to ensure individuals and teams are prepared for project rollouts.
- To provide support to the operations development team, including with the development of short- and long-term goals and support with the management of the operations project pipeline and portfolio.

Your skills and qualifications

- 3-5 years of relevant experience (preferably in operations, change management, resource management).
- Experience with project management approaches and tools.



- An understanding of how people go through a change, including how change management (principles, methodologies, and tools) can be applied to project management approaches.
- Exceptional communication skills, both written and verbal, including the ability to articulate clear messages to a variety of audiences (both technical and non-technical). Fluency in English.
- Ability to establish and maintain strong relationships at all levels in an organisation.
- Ability to influence others and move toward a common vision or goal.
- Resiliency, with the perseverance to succeed in a challenging and ambitious working environment.
- A results-oriented, proactive problem-solver who has great organisational and prioritisation skills.
